

LARGS YACHT HAVEN ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Largs Yacht Haven owns and operates the 700 berth marina at Largs on the Firth of Clyde. This Environmental Policy covers all aspects of our business and aims to bring awareness to our staff and customers and bring best practice to all aspects of our operation.

The manager is responsible for integrating and maintaining environmental considerations into the business, with assistance from the assistant manager.

Financial and time resources have been allocated to implement the policy and to provide an understanding to both staff and customers.

Our objectives are:

- To comply with all current and relevant regulations
- To reduce the use of consumables and energy
- Reduce hazardous waste generation
- Minimise the impact of activities on neighbours

We provide free of charge to our customers:

- Paper and cardboard recycling
- Glass recycling
- Waste oil and battery collection for recycling
- Sewage pump out facilities

Our targets are:

- 3% reduction in general waste disposal by 2016 (measured by number of skip uplifts)
- 3% reduction in water consumption by 2016 (based on metered supply)
- 3% reduction in energy consumption by 2016 (based on metered supply)
- 3% increase in waste recycling by 2016 (based on number of uplifts)

We monitor usage and consumption on a monthly basis and track increases/decreases

This Environmental Policy is on display on the public notice boards at marina reception. It is published in our annual yearbook and is on our group website (www.yachthavens.com).

This policy is subject to review every three years (2014/2017 etc).
