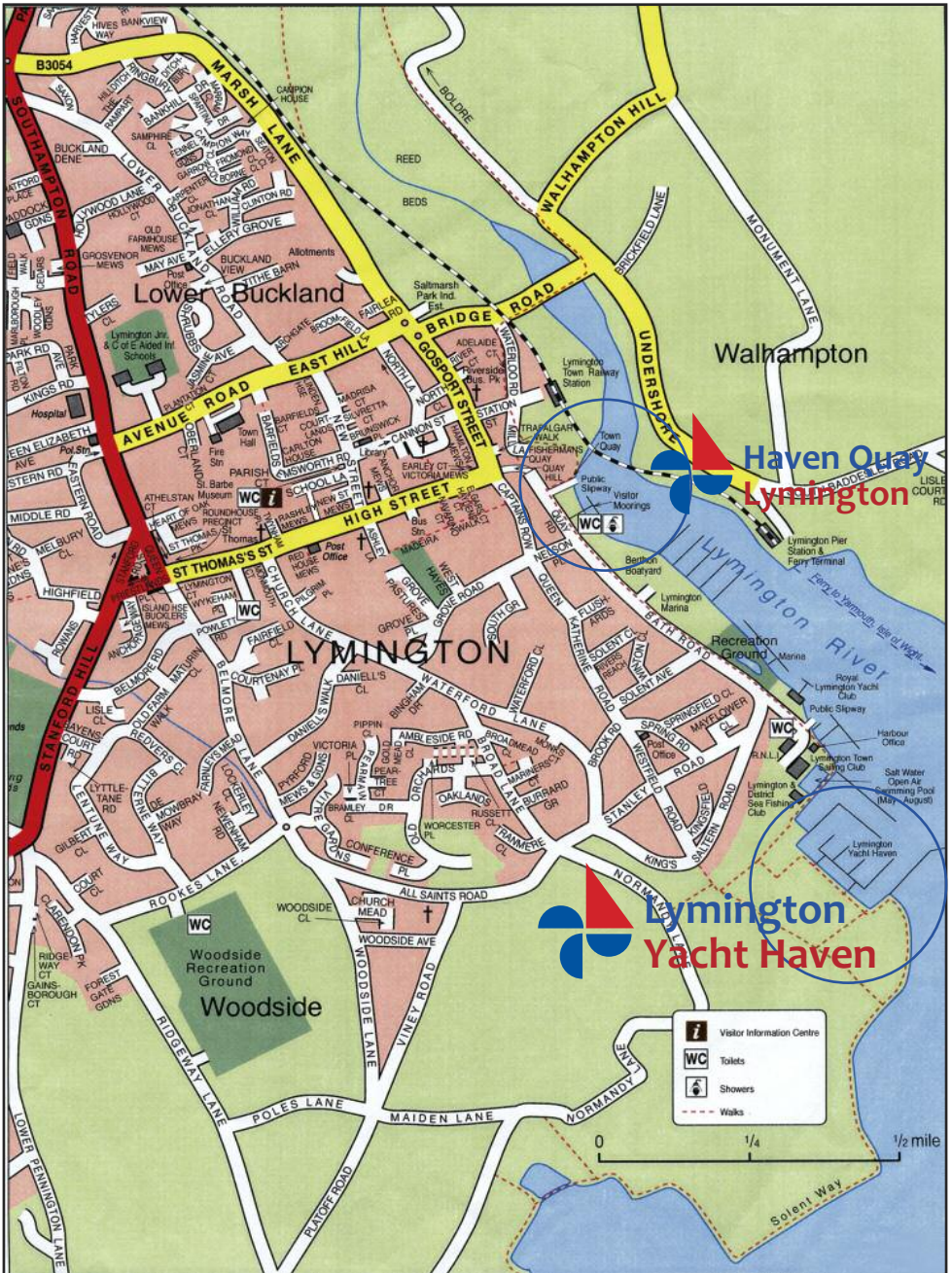

To gain access, visit your Marina Reception to request your Unique Access Code. On your wireless-enabled device connect to 'Spectrum Marina WiFi', and open your usual web browser. You will see Yacht Havens log-in screen, and a box that invites you to enter your Access Code.

When you've entered your code, you follow the instructions to set up your account online. When you've completed registration you will be logged in and can use your web browser as normal.

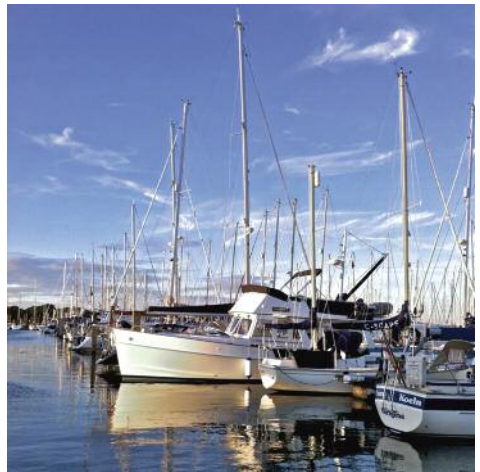

Terms and conditions apply

Our marina reception and site is open 24/7 for berthing, fuel, laundry and showers. We also have an on site restaurant/licensed bar and a chandlery/mini-market which are both open all year round. Our hoist and hard standing facilities are available weekdays or special call out for emergencies.



MARINA INFORMATION

This handbook is intended as a useful guide to assist you during your stay at Lympington Yacht Haven.

It includes all the information you may need to know about our marina and its services, as well as tidal predictions for 2012, navigational information and places to visit ashore.

Marina Berths

- 500 berths, fully serviced with power and water
- Visitor berths, subject to availability

Free WiFi

Available throughout the marina – to get connected please collect your unique code from the marina reception.

Information for Visitors

- We have 100% residential occupancy. When a resident boat vacates their berth, a visitor's berth is created and visiting boats are welcome
- A limited number of visitor's bookings can be taken in advance, but a phone call or a call on VHF channel 80 on the day is necessary for berthing instructions
- Berthing is payable in advance and berths should be vacated by noon on the day of departure. A VHF call is appreciated as confirmation of your departure
- Visitors and crew car parking is on the gravel hard standing area

Marina Reception

- Open from 0700hrs to 1900hrs, 364 days a year (closed Christmas Day)
- Monitors VHF Channel 80 during these times
- Weather forecasts posted in reception daily
- 24 hour flatscreen weather and news display
- Bags of ice for sale
- Our fax number is 01590 678186. You are welcome to use our sending and receiving facilities for a small fee per page
- Post may be collected from the A-Z pigeonholes. Outgoing mail may be left at Reception as we have a weekday's collection

Security 24/7

- The marina is manned 24 hours a day, 364 days a year
- Night Security – Outside office hours regular security patrols ensure security and night time dock master duties. If you require assistance, please call 01590 677071 or 07702 165989 out of hours
- Annual berth holders are issued with security key fobs to gain access to the pontoon bridges, the shower blocks and the main berth holders' car park, which is situated at the southern end of the site. Visitors are issued with the current entry code (changed regularly)
- Parking is at "owner's risk", so please do not leave valuables in your car when unattended
- CCTV surveillance exists throughout the marina

Dry Berthing at Haven Quay

Situated in the heart of Lympington, Haven Quay's unique location and facilities provide an excellent Dry Berthing and Boatyard service. Tel: 01590 677072. For more information see Haven Quay feature on pages 14 & 15.

Boatyard Services

- We operate the hoist, crane, pressure wash and hard standing areas. All bookings should be made through the marina office
- Scrub/antifoul offers are available at certain times of year; see notice board for details
- Storage ashore is available (free of charge to annual berth holders between 1st May and 31st August)
- Winter storage should be booked using the appropriate booking form available from the marina office. Berth-holders have a chance to book early and are charged at a reduced rate
- Trailers or cradles, which must be clearly identified, can be stored by arrangement only
- We operate a 24-hour emergency haul-out service all year round



MARINA INFORMATION continued...

Toilets and Showers

“The Fortress” as it is known, conveniently located near the centre bridgehead, is a purpose built shower/toilet block. Open 24/7 to berth-holders and accessible for visitors by access code throughout the year. Additional facilities are available in the Main Marina building and on H/K pontoon.

Lauderette

- Open 24/7 all year round
- Washing machines and tumble driers are coin operated. Powder and change are available.

Trolleys

- Are provided for your convenience and mostly £1 or token operated
- May be collected from any one of the three bridgehead trolley parks
- Please do not leave trolleys on the pontoons, return them to the nearest trolley park
- In the event of a trolley finding its way into the water, please contact marina staff immediately

Water and Electricity

- All pontoons have access to fresh water hosepipes
- All berths have individual power points, except fingerette and restricted access berths. Due to their proximity to water, these operate on sensitive trips and have the capacity to supply 3 to 3.5 kW at 240v with a 15 amp current
- Metered cables can be ordered and purchased from the marina reception
- Electricity is charged in addition to the annual berthing fee and berth holders must have a metered cable for use of electricity. Visitors berthing rates include a charge for electricity

Fuel

- Marine diesel (Gasoil) and unleaded petrol are available 24/7 all year round
- The fuel dock is situated on the sea wall in front of the marina office
- Volume discounts on gasoil (>100 ltr, >300 ltr) and petrol (>100 ltr) are available but only if paid for by cash, cheque or debit card

Sewage Pump-Out Facility

Boat owners may use this unit (tokens are available from the fuel kiosk) to pump out their own holding tanks at the fuel berth.

Calor and Camping Gaz Refills

Bottled gas is available 24/7 all year round from the fuel dock. Also available from the chandlers at the site entrance.

Waste Disposal

- Large skips are situated close to each of the three bridgeheads and are for disposal of general domestic waste only from boats (EC regulations apply)
- Waste oil tanks are adjacent to the above
- Spent batteries and used oil filters – for information on disposal, please ask at the marina office
- Bottle banks for recycling can be found on site, at each bridgehead and at the back of the Haven Bar

Please help us to keep the site clean and tidy and inform the marina staff of any spillages.

Local weather forecasts are posted in reception daily and you can view live weather forecasts by following the links on our website – www.yachthavens.com

Local Supermarkets and Cash Points

There is a Waitrose, Tesco and M&S Food in Lymington town centre open 7 days a week. There are various cash points on the High Street.

How to Become a Berth Holder

Berths can become available at any time throughout the year. Please contact us to discuss availability or simply complete the waiting list application form on page 41 of this handbook. It is possible we may have a space immediately; if not for a deposit of £300 (deductible from your first annual berthing fees or returnable on exiting the list) you will be put on our waiting list and contacted when a suitable berth becomes available.

By sea

Lymington Yacht Haven is the first marina you come to up the Lymington River from the Solent.

By road

Exit the M27 at Junction 1, following signs for Lymington on the A337. At Lymington, the marina directions are indicated on brown tourist signs, initially as Marinas & Riverside, and then as Yacht Haven. By exiting the M27 at Junction 2, one can reach Lymington via Beaulieu, avoiding the potential bottleneck at Lyndhurst during the busy season.

By rail

Regular half hourly service from the main line station of Brockenhurst through to Lymington Town. It is then a 20 minute walk to the marina from the station. (See map on page 5).



APPROACH & NAVIGATIONAL INFORMATION

Lymington River/Lymington Yacht Haven

- Approach to the river WPT 50° 44'.20N 01° 30'.28W.
- Leading lights 319 degrees, fixed red 12/17m 8M.
- First port hand mark – Jack in the Basket – post with barrel – Flashing red (2 seconds).
- During daylight hours the RLYC starting platform (unlit) is the first starboard mark.
- Channel is marked by red piles with square top marks to port, green piles with triangular top marks to starboard.
- Port side has 4 lights flashing red (2 seconds) and Harpers Post quick 3 flash white (10 seconds).
- Starboard side 7 lights flashing green (2 seconds).
- Leading lights for the Yacht Haven are at 244°, both fixed orange, before reaching Harpers Post.

Weather Forecast Information

- A weather station is located in the foyer area. This includes a wind speed and direction indicator, a barometer, Navtex and the latest weather map and forecast updated at 0830 each day.
- Further local information can be obtained by telephoning Marinecall on 0871 200 3985.
- The latest weather map and forecast is posted at the bridgeheads each day, or a copy is available from the Marina office.

HM Solent Coastguard Tel: 023 9255 2100

The marine rescue centre is located at Lee on Solent. They maintain a continuous VHF watch on channel 16, working channel 67.

HM Customs & Excise Tel: 0845 010 9000

Customs forms for visiting non EC countries are available at Reception and a Customs post box is situated outside the foyer on the wall.

RNLI Tel: 0845 122 6999

Free expert safety advice is available to all boat users. Ask for SEA CHECK, to arrange an appointment aboard your vessel.

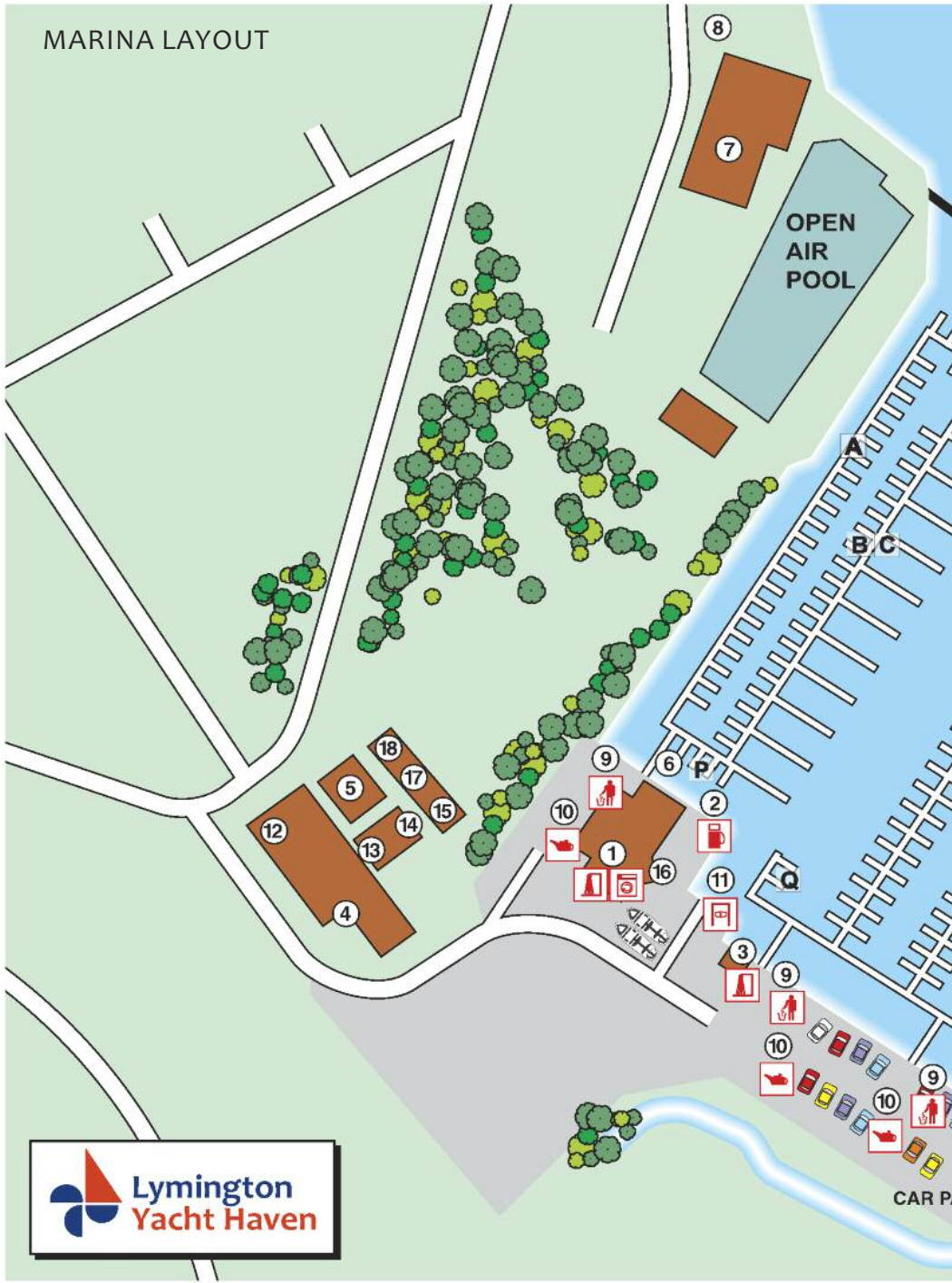


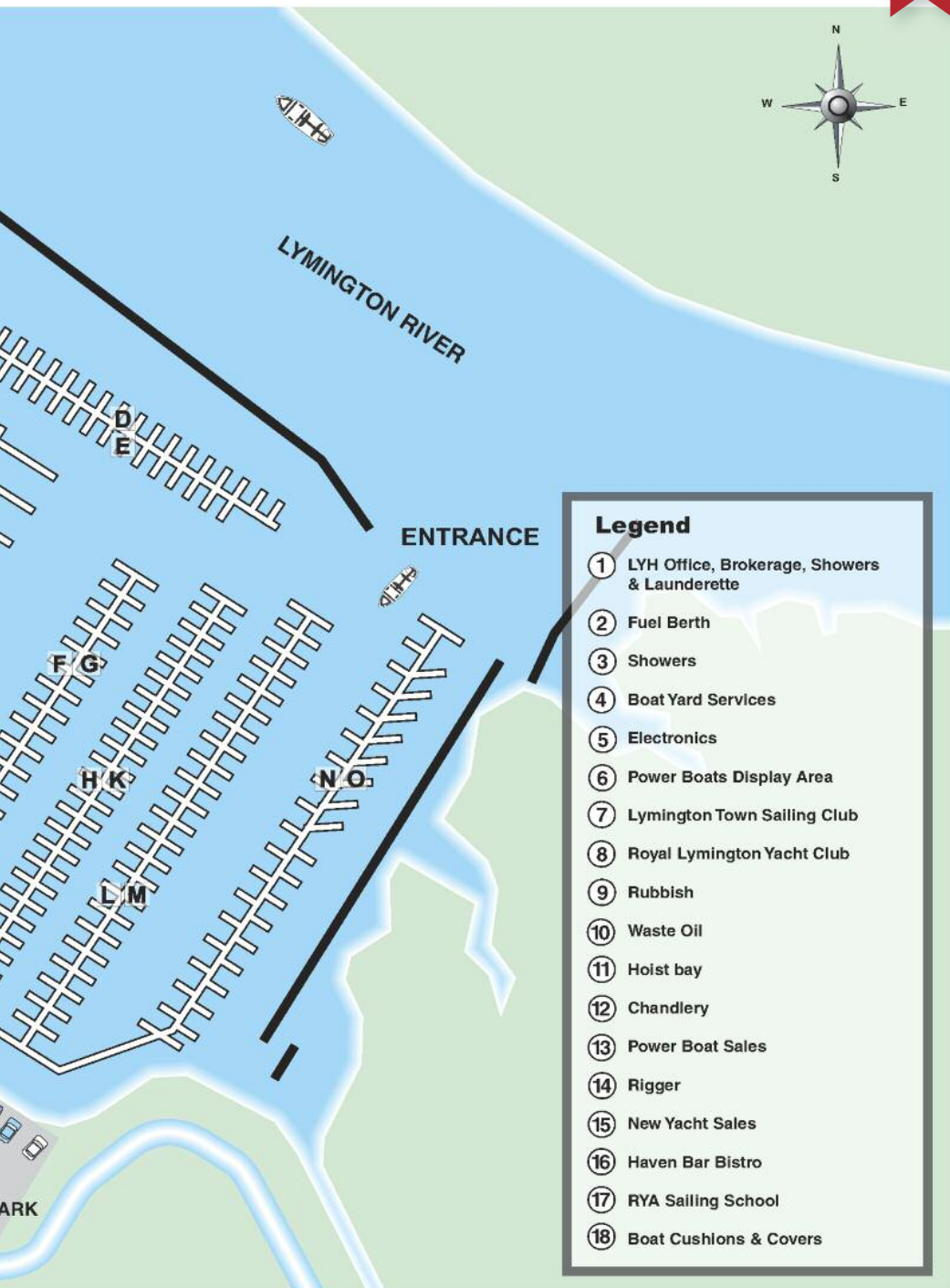
Tidal Information

- The Standard Port for Lymington is Portsmouth. Low water at Lymington is usually 20 minutes prior to low water Portsmouth, whether neaps or springs.
- Double high waters occur at or near springs and on other occasions there is a stand lasting about 2 hours. Predictions refer to the first high water when there are two. At other times they refer to the middle of the stand.
- Tide Tables for 2012 are printed at the back of this Handbook for ease of reference.

HELP US PROTECT THE ENVIRONMENT

Lymington Yacht Haven is committed to promoting environmental awareness and best practice so we can all continue to enjoy our boating in a clean and healthy environment.

Our objectives are:

- To comply with all current and relevant regulations
- To reduce the use of consumables and energy
- Reduce hazardous waste generation
- Minimise the impact of activities on neighbours

We provide to our customers:

- Paper and cardboard recycling
- Glass recycling
- Waste oil and battery collection for recycling
- Sewage pump out facilities

In the marina and on the water:

- Please do not disturb wildlife with excessive wash
- Please avoid water pollution and use the facilities ashore (toilets, waste bins, sewage pump out)
- Please do not pump out bilges in the marina
- If you have or see a fuel leak please notify marina staff immediately
- Please keep your boat washed and antifouled annually to prevent marine growth

YOUR SAFETY

We aim to provide a relaxed and safe environment for you to enjoy your boating in and ask that all marina rules and regulations are followed.

IN CASE OF FIRE ON BOARD

- Sound the alarm at each bridgehead and notify marina staff
- Call 999
- Only tackle the fire if it is safe to do so with the extinguishers provided in the emergency cabinets.
- Retreat to a safe distance and locate the nearest fire assembly point.



GENERAL SAFETY

- Please familiarize yourself with the location of lifesaving and firefighting equipment on the pontoons and ashore.
- Please take extra care in snow and icy conditions as the pontoons can be slippery and ensure appropriate footwear is worn at all times
- Please do not ride bicycles or scooters on the pontoons
- Please ensure all children and non-swimmers wear a life jacket at all times
- Please do not allow dogs to foul the pontoons or yard areas, if they do please clean up
- Swimming and scuba diving are not permitted in the marina
- Please keep below 2 knots when in the marina and mind your wash
- Always isolate gas and fuel when leaving your boat.
- Always use own hosepipe for drinking water and filling water tanks, and never leave hoses running or hanging in the water.
- Do not remove supports from vessels in the yard, or run engines of vessels stored ashore. All furling sails must be removed prior to boats being lifted.

For your safety and enjoyment of our marina please be sure to follow the guidelines. Comprehensive marina rules can be found on the reverse of your berthing contracts. All boats and contractors using the marina, ashore or afloat, must have a minimum of £3,000,000 third party Insurance.

RYA ACTIVE MARINA PROGRAMME

Yacht Havens have joined the RYA Active Marina Programme which aims to help you to make the most of life with your boat.

Through a new programme of events and opportunities at Lymington Yacht Haven in 2012, you and your crew can take part in practical training workshops which are tailor-made to build your knowledge and boost your confidence. This could be a refresher on manoeuvring and berthing, crew training, or even a specialist workshop which will help you to tackle the tasks which challenge you the most.

Alongside workshops, the Active Marina Programme will also present you with the opportunity to get to know and socialise with the people at your marina. Enjoy cruising with other berth holders and boat owners and spend time with like-minded people at social events.

THINGS TO DO ASHORE

Shopping: Lymington hosts a lively street market every Saturday in the main High Street with a number of stalls catering for all tastes. In addition there is a wide variety of shops, galleries, boutiques, and a Waitrose, Tesco and M&S Food. The town centre is approx 10 minutes walk from the marina.

Walking: The marina has direct access to the Coastal Footpath offering superb walks along the foreshore to Keyhaven (approx an hour and a half walk) and Hurst Point where the Solent rushes in/out. There are also numerous other walks and a wide range of recreational facilities available throughout the New Forest National Park which surrounds the town.

Swimming: There is an open air pool just next to the marina which is normally open during the summer months Tel: 01590 674865. In addition there are heated pools at the Recreation Centre Tel: 01590 670333, a 15 minutes walk away, and at Elmers Court Country Club Tel: 01590 676011, on the other side of the river near the WightLink ferry terminal. Also there is a Spa Complex at Careys Manor in Brockenhurst Tel: 01590 623551, 15 minutes on the train.

Cycling: Bike Hire can be arranged through New Forest Experience based in Brockenhurst Tel: 01590 624204. Delivery to the marina can be arranged, depending on the number of bikes required.

Rackets: There are two tennis courts at Woodside gardens, 5 minutes walk, and squash courts at the Recreation Centre and Elmers Court Country Club.

Golf: Walhampton Golf course is a 9-hole course in a tranquil setting, bordered by woodland with views extending across the Solent to the Isle of Wight Tel: 01590 689631.

Fishing Trips: We do not permit fishing in the marina, but fishing on the sea wall is popular with annual competitions. Daily fishing charter trips run from the Town Quay.
