





# 10 years of the Ellen MacArthur **Cancer Trust in Largs**

Hundreds of young people living through and beyond cancer have sailed out of Largs Yacht Haven with the Ellen MacArthur Cancer Trust since the charity opened its base here in 2013.

Cancer can have a big impact on a young person's mental wellbeing. For many of them, picking up from where they left off before cancer is not possible. That's where the Trust comes in.

Scotland's stunning west coast is the perfect location for these young people to feel inspired to believe in a brighter future, following the end of their cancer treatment.

They spend four days sailing with the Trust, living in close guarters with others who have been through the same as them. They can open up about their experiences with people the same age, which many have never done before, helping them feel more accepted and like they are not the 'only one'.

Together, the young people helm, raise the sails, tie the fenders, and get involved with all aspects of life on board. Getting so hands on around the yachts helps them realise what they are capable of again and is a major boost to their sense of independence.

They leave with renewed optimism, more equipped to re-establish their place in the world and reconnect with friends and family.

For those who would like further support, each year every young person is invited to come back, with the option to spend five days cruising on the Firth of Clyde.



# Native Oysters restored to the Firth of Clyde

The Wild Oysters Project, a partnership between ZSL (Zoological Society of London), Blue Marine Foundation and British Marine, aims to restore Britain's seas back to health working with marinas and boat owners to put oysters back in the ocean.

Oysters play an important role in our marine environment filtering the water and providing habitat for lots of other species. Unfortunately, oysters are under threat from unsustainable practices in our oceans and we have lost over 95% of oysters across Europe.

This year, over 1,000 native oysters have been returned to waters in the Firth of Clyde, housed in specialist oyster nurseries suspended under the pontoons at Largs Yacht Haven. The oysters here in Largs will release up to 500 million free swimming larvae each year!

Oysters are filter feeders and can be affected by pollution of all kinds. As boat owners we can reduce our impact and help native oysters to recover.



# **Cruising Inspiration**

Our top cruising destinations Largs Yacht Haven is based perfectly amongst lochs and islands with fishing villages and harbours as near as half an hour sail away. The inner Clyde offers ideal day cruising, whilst the more open west coast and Ireland is only a day away.

Millport, Isle of Cumbrae – 4nm Known as the 'Jewel of the Clyde' – it's a great spot for shopping, golf, fishing and cycling. Millport also has a lovely sandy beach, perfect for young children.

Rothesay, Isle of Bute – 6nm A pretty fishing harbour and a lively town with shops, restaurants and pubs just a few steps from the harbour. There are visitor pontoons in Rothesay harbour and nearby Port Bannatyne. Kyles of Bute – 14 nm A small, pretty village with a community garden – perfect for picnics – and a great hotel. Lots of opportunities for walks along the stunning shoreline.

Tarbert, Loch Fyne – 22 nm A tiny but atmospheric fishing village with fantastic views from Robert the Bruce's 14th century castle. Take a walk to the pretty shell-lined beach at the end of Pier Road.

Brodick, Isle of Arran – 16 nm This is a popular destination for walkers – due to its great hills and beautiful views. The village has lots to offer including hotels, restaurants and a golf course. Brodick Castle is also well worth a visit, and has a wonderful new adventure playground.

Troon Yacht Haven – 20 nm We may be biased, but Troon has beautiful scenery, some of the finest golf courses in the world and gourmet dining! Don't forget to enjoy a cocktail on the terrace at Scotts overlooking the marina.


