For day sailing and anchorages, choose a quiet natural harbour such as Newtown Creek or head for the hustle and bustle of Southampton. Beyond the Solent, to the West, there's the natural harbour at Poole, Studland Bay and Sandbanks within easy reach, and Portsmouth to the East – one of the most historical harbours in the UK.

So many places to explore, and all within a day or two's sail.

These are some of our favourite places to visit – just a stone's throw away.

The Hut at Colwell Bay,

IoW – 4.5 nm A great beach restaurant and stunning sunsets, anchor up and they will give you a lift ashore.

Alum Bay, IoW – 6.5 nm This gorgeous anchorage overlooks The Needles, and it's a fantastic spot for swimming.

Yarmouth, IoW – 3 nm A friendly harbour with plenty to do including beautiful walks and superb restaurants.

Newtown Creek, IoW – 5 nm A stunning anchorage in a nature reserve. Take a picnic and tender ashore to enjoy the beach. Cowes, IoW – 9.5 nm An iconic yachting destination with lots to see and do. If you have time, pop to The Folly Inn about 2 miles further up the River Medina.

Hurst Castle – 3.5 nm

Good for a lunch stop, this landmark close to Lymington River has an open anchorage, but be careful of the strong tidal current alongside the beach.

Beaulieu River – 7.5 nm

Experience tranquillity and stunning natural beauty on the Beaulieu River. Tie up to one of the river moorings or visit the historic Buckler's Hard.
