- Mobile crane for mast and engine lifts

Hoisting and lifting

Our 75 ton boat hoist and mobile crane operate Monday to Friday, with a 24 hour emergency haul-out service operating all year round.

Our large, fully enclosed hangars provide safe, secure storage for times when project work requires being away from the elements. Our yard provides storage for a large number of boats who require storage for any period of time. 





It's an alternative to traditional marina berthing. Your boat is stored indoors on our custom racking system, and we're available 7 days a week, 365 days a year, to launch your boat for you whenever you want to use it.





Cruising inspiration

Perfectly placed just a stone's throw from one of England's finest natural harbours, Plymouth Sound, whatever the weather or wind direction, you'll find plenty of peaceful and well-protected anchorages within easy reach of Plymouth Yacht Haven and the Dry Stack.

You can stay local and explore the Rivers Plym, Tamar, Yealm and Lynher. Enjoy a day's sail to Looe, Salcombe, Fowey, Torbay, Dartmouth or Falmouth. Or head further afield to the Isles of Scilly, the Channel Islands and the north and west coasts of France. There really is something for everyone to enjoy.

Here are some of our favourite spots and navigation tips...

Kingsand, Cawsand Bay – 4nm

The approach is wide open and safe. Sheltered in the prevailing south-westerly winds, this free anchorage can be a wonderful lunchtime or overnight stop. There's plenty of room to land on the beach where you'll be rewarded with easy access to a choice of pubs. You'll even find kayak and SUP hire. Alternatively, it's a great place for a swim.

Cellar Bay, River Yealm – 6nm

This secluded beach is away from the beaten track for landlubbers, which makes it paradise for us sea-goers! There's plenty of space to anchor off the beach and a few caves to explore once you're ashore. The Ship Inn in Noss Mayo is a mile walk away, or just anchor up and enjoy the scenery! A really good spot in an easterly breeze.

Polkerris, St Austell Bay – 26nm

At high tide, you can tie up at the old harbour wall on this secluded beach where you'll find a great pub and café on the shoreside. Alternatively, you can anchor just offshore. Join the SW Coast Path and walk up to Gribbin Head to see the famous red and white tower, known locally as "The Stack," marking the entrance to Fowey Harbour. Alternatively, stay on the beach and hire a SUP to enjoy the calm waters.

Dittisham, River Dart – 40nm

Venture beyond the main towns of Dartmouth and Kingswear on the River Dart, heading north past Agatha Christie's house. The cruise beyond the busy towns becomes peaceful with tall woods lining both sides of the river. At Dittisham, it suddenly opens up into a large bay where you'll find a brilliant pub (The Ferry Boat Inn) and plenty of visitor moorings.

River Fal – 41nm

Where to start when talking about the Fal and Carrick Roads? On one side of the river, the busy and historical town of Falmouth with Pendennis Castle, a bustling high street, old quays and the maritime museum. On the other, the stunning St Mawes village with the infamous Castle and St Anthony's Head. Heading further upstream, you'll find large ships laid up, Pandora Inn pub on the edge of Restronguet Creek, beautiful winding inlets and coves, and plenty of wildlife. What's not to love?





Finding Plymouth

Plymouth is on the south coast of Devon. It lies between the mouths of the rivers Plym to the east and Tamar to the west, where they join Plymouth Sound.

By sea

Plymouth Sound can be entered via the Western or Eastern channels that are well lit and buoyed with no real hazards.

There is not less than 3.7 metres of depth at MLWS and so is navigable by most yachts at all states of the tide.

Head for the Royal Citadel on Plymouth Hoe. Once the Mount Batten breakwater is passed to starboard, follow the Cattewater channel, where you will see Plymouth Yacht Haven on your starboard side.

To reach Yacht Haven Quay, continue up the Cattewater, leaving Plymouth Yacht Haven to starboard. Our waiting pontoons are on the eastern riverbank, approximately 500 metres downstream of the Laira Road Bridge. It's hard to miss the Dry Stack building dominating the skyline!

By road

To Plymouth Yacht Haven

- Turn left off A38 at Marsh Mills roundabout onto A374 signed Plymouth City Centre.
- After less than a mile get into the left hand lane and follows signs for Kingsbridge A379.
- This takes you across Laira Bridge where you'll see the first signs for Mount Batten and Turnchapel.
- After crossing the Laira Bridge, at the first roundabout turn right.
- At the next roundabout (mini) take the second exit, cross pedestrian lights, and continue straight on until traffic lights at crossroads.
- Turn right and then go straight through a second set of lights.
- Keep on this road (for approx 1 1/2 miles), crossing straight over three mini-roundabouts and continuing.
- At the next roundabout, turn right into Plymouth Yacht Haven.
- Post code for your sat nav is PL9 9XH.

To Yacht Haven Quay

- As above, to the Laira Bridge. After crossing the Laira Bridge, at the first roundabout, turn right.
- At the next roundabout (mini) take the fourth exit and continue along Breakwater Road.
- After 500 yards, bear left, signposted Yacht Haven Quay, where you'll see our double entrance gates in front of you.

By rail

You can escape from London to Plymouth on the Great Western Railway in less than 3 hours 30 minutes.

Up to 24 trains make the journey from London Paddington down to Plymouth direct, some even taking in the natural beauty of the North Wessex Downs along the way.





